

Boca Grande Club Rules & Etiquette

To help make the Club an enjoyable and safe place, please remember to observe the following:

- ◆ ***Boats, trailers, buses, or jet skis are not permitted on property.***
- ◆ Landings and entrance areas must be kept clear of any items.
- ◆ Do not hang items from any outside railings.
- ◆ Bicycles must be stored in bicycle racks.
- ◆ For safety reasons skateboarding, rollerblading or scooter use is not permitted on our property.
- ◆ Outdoor grilling is limited to gas or electric and is only as provided.
- ◆ No charcoal grilling is allowed.
- ◆ Pets are not permitted on Club facilities.
- ◆ Maximum occupancy of rental units not to exceed allowable limits.
- ◆ Please observe speed limit of 15 mph.
- ◆ Smoking is not permitted in any of the units, lanais, screened or open decks, Clubrooms or indoor facilities, directly outside entry doors, any of the buildings common areas or on the pool decks.

Pool Rules

- ◆ ***Children who are not toilet trained are not permitted in any of the Club pools even if they are wearing swimmies or protective clothing; a baby pool is provided for their use.***
- ◆ See pool sign for additional pool rules.
- ◆ Shower before entering pool or spa.
- ◆ Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all Club pools.
- ◆ Children under the age of 16 are not permitted in the Jacuzzi.
- ◆ Club pool towels are not to be removed from the pool area.
- ◆ Noodles and floats are not permitted in our pools except for organized aerobic classes.

Beach Rules

- ◆ When leaving the beach, please help by pulling your lounge chair up past the high tide line.
- ◆ Do not move cabanas as they are anchored to the ground.
- ◆ Close the beach umbrella when you are finished using it.
- ◆ County law prohibits pets on the beach.

Fitness Center

- ◆ Children under the age of 18 are not permitted in the fitness center.
- ◆ Under no circumstances may you enter the fitness center wearing shoes that have been worn on the tennis courts.
- ◆ Please keep the volume of the television to a minimum so as not to disturb others.
